## REGISTERING A SHORT-TERM RESIDENTIAL RENTAL

- All non-exempt short-term residential rental operators in Loudoun County are required to register their properties annually under the local ordinance.
- Registration is available online and free of charge at loudoun.gov/ShortTermRentals.
- After completing the registration form, operators receive a confirmation e-mail with a copy of the registration for their records.
- The registration is not a permit.

## **EXEMPTIONS** The following types of operators do not have to register:

- Real estate professionals licensed by the Commonwealth of Virginia Real Estate Board.
- Property owners who are represented by a real estate professional licensed by the Commonwealth of Virginia Real Estate Board.
- A person registered pursuant to the Virginia Real Estate Time-Share Act (§ 55-360 et seq.) of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended.
- A person licensed or registered with the Commonwealth of Virginia Department of Health, related to the provision of room or space for lodging.
- A person licensed or registered with Loudoun County, related to the rental or management of real estate, including licensed real estate professionals, hotels, motels, campgrounds, and bed and breakfast establishments.

## CONSIDERATIONS REGARDING SHORT-TERM RESIDENTIAL RENTALS

- If you live in an incorporated town, contact the town government for information regarding it's regulations.
- If you live in a homeowners or condo association, contact your association to verify it's regulations regarding short-term rentals.
- Contact the Department of Planning & Zoning if you have questions about using your property for a short-term residential rental based on the Zoning Ordinance. Zoning Administration will determine if a Zoning Permit is needed. Contact Planning and Zoning at dpz@loudoun.gov or 703-777-0246.
- Contact the Health Department to determine what is required for a short-term residential rental at health@loudoun.gov or 703-777-0234.
- There may be tax requirements associated with operating a short-term rental. Contact the Commissioner of the Revenue at btcor@loudoun.gov or 703-777-0260.
- Check with your insurance company for applicable issues.
